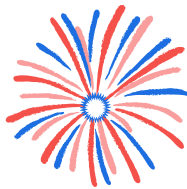
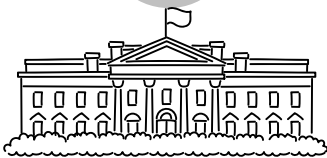
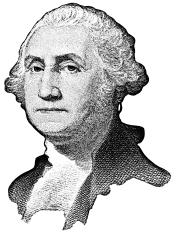
Rationale:
